

Summer Courses 2026: Participant Information Package

Welcome to the Espoo School of Art Summer Courses!

Espoo School of Art will organize summer courses in June and late July–early August on the following weeks:

- Mon–Fri, June 1–5, 2026
- Mon–Fri, June 8–12, 2026
- Mon–Fri, August 3–7, 2026

GENERAL INFORMATION

We recommend comfortable, weather-appropriate clothes that can get messy. The school is not responsible for any stains on clothing. As some course activities may take place outdoors, please bring a water bottle, sunhat, and sunscreen. If necessary, also pack rain gear.

COURSE LOCATIONS

The classroom entrances are to the left of the main entrance at street level. Do not enter through the main lobby.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

Children under 9 years of age may not leave the premises alone at the end of the course without written permission from their guardian. Children aged 9 and over may leave independently unless the guardian has submitted a written request for them to wait.

Please inform the course teacher in writing if:

- your child under 9 years **IS ALLOWED** to leave alone
- your child aged 9 or older **IS NOT ALLOWED** to leave alone

If your child needs to leave the course early on any day, please inform the course teacher in advance in writing.

Note: After the end of the course day, students are not allowed to stay in the classroom to wait for pickup.

MEALS

Meal arrangements vary depending on the course's duration and schedule. Please check the course description for the specific meals included in your course.

Packed meals can be stored in a fridge and heated in a microwave. A kettle is also available.

We accommodate allergies and special diets based on the information provided in the registration form.

RETURNING OF STUDENT ARTWORK

Artworks created during the course are returned to the students at the end of the course, at the latest. The artworks cannot be stored on the premises of the School of Art after the course (with the exception of ceramics courses, for which the works are collected at a later, separately announced time).

INSURANCE AND EMERGENCIES

The school has accident insurance for students during lessons and travel to and from school. The course teacher is responsible for the students during lessons and outdoor activities, but not during commutes.

If a student falls ill during the course day, the guardian will be contacted immediately and asked to collect the child.

In case of an accident, the course teacher will take the student for medical treatment and inform the guardian. A student who has been injured will not be sent home without an adult escort.

Please ensure that a sick child or one showing symptoms of a respiratory infection does not attend the course.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Registration is binding. Cancellations must be sent via email to: kurssit@espoonkuvis.fi

If you need to cancel your registration, please notify us as soon as possible or at least 14 days before the course begins.

- Cancellations made less than 14 days before the course start: 50 % of the course fee will be charged.
- Cancellations made on or after the first day of the course: 100 % of the course fee will be charged.
- All cancellations are subject to a 23 € administrative fee, which is deducted from the course fee.

Refunds are processed via Paytrail to the card or account originally used for payment. Processing time is up to 14 days.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

If there is anything specific the course teacher should know about your child (e.g. language skills), please contact them before the course starts.
