

## Why Natural Stone?

Each piece of natural stone we use — whether marble, onyx, or travertine — is a one-of-a-kind creation of the Earth. Its organic veins, color shifts, and textures tell a story millions of years in the making. Choosing natural stone means embracing authenticity, sustainability, and timeless beauty.

Natural materials evolve with you. While they're incredibly durable, they require proper care to maintain their elegance. At Royal Bee Design, we want your pieces to last a lifetime, so here's everything you need to know to take care of them.

## General Maintenance Tips

- Avoid harsh chemicals: Never use cleaning agents containing alcohol, acetone, acids, or abrasives.
- Frequent cleaning is key: Wipe down surfaces regularly to avoid buildup of dust, humidity, or residues — especially on gold-plated, chrome-plated, or painted finishes.

- Act fast on spills: If anything spills on your piece, clean it immediately using mild soap and water to prevent permanent staining.
- No colored cleaners: Avoid colored detergents that may leave pigment behind.
- Gentle only: Use only soft cotton cloths or non-abrasive sponges — never metal scrubbers or rough fabrics.
- Color variations are natural: Veins, stains, and shifts in tone are part of the stone's character, not imperfections.
- Sunlight awareness: Extended exposure to direct sunlight may change the stone's coloration over time.

## Routine Cleaning Instructions

- Use mild detergents: Only soft, pH-neutral soaps or stone-specific cleaners are recommended.
- Rinse well: Always rinse with clean water and wipe dry to avoid limescale and water spots.

- Apply with cloth — not directly: Never spray or pour cleaner directly onto the stone. Instead, apply it to your cloth first.
- No detergent mixing: Combining cleaners can cause chemical damage.
- Personal care product warning: Residue from soaps, shampoos, makeup, and lotions can stain stone — rinse off all products after use.

## Dealing with Limescale

- Prevention is best: Dry any water spots immediately to prevent buildup.
- For removal: Use a non-abrasive cloth or sponge with a limescale remover approved for use on natural stone.
- Final rinse & dry: Rinse with water and dry thoroughly with a soft cloth after cleaning.

## What to Avoid

- No acidic foods or liquids: Citrus, vinegar, wine, coffee, and tomato sauce can etch and stain stone — clean immediately if contact occurs.
- No metal tools or rough sponges: These will scratch or dull the finish.
- No aggressive anti-scale or metal cleaners: They can oxidize delicate finishes, especially gold or chrome.
- Avoid moisture displacers: Products used on glass (like water-repellent sprays) may damage natural stone finishes.
- Keep away from dyes & colorants: Nail polish, hair dye, and tanning products can cause irreversible stains.

By following these care instructions, your Royal Bee Design pieces will retain their beauty and natural elegance for years to come.
