

Plimmerton Boating Club has been an integral part of the Community since 1925, thanks to the vision of locals collectively building ramps & jetty to access the sea. Initially in the 1920's this was just sail-powered boats but now motor boats, kayaks, jet skis, SUP's & more are launched most days with easy access to world-class fishing & sailing conditions.

Who can be a member of Plimmerton Boating Club?

Membership of Plimmerton Boating Club is open to everyone who has a genuine interest in being associated with club activities, or owns a boat, or is a crew member on a boat/watercraft

What are the types of Membership?

The two broad types are 'full' and 'social' members.

- FULL membership covers a household and gives drive-on access through the gate, and slipway access of the ramp for launching. Full members qualify to hire boat sheds/parks at additional cost, subject to availability. Discounts for Veteran & Juniors may apply
- **SOCIAL** members are those interested in club activities & supporting their local community club. They do not have a gate access card to use the slipway/ramp for launching.

What are all the other buildings & boats sitting around the club?

● The area owned by the club has 40 boat sheds and 55 boat parks. These are available to be hired out to FULL members, for an additional cost. Applications for parks and sheds are made to the Club Commodore

What else do I get for my membership?

What does a membership cost?

- The membership subscription period runs from 1st October to 30th September.

 These annual member 'subs' are set each year at the Annual General Meeting, usually held in August every year
- Subs are invoiced in August/September and due to be paid in October for the year in advance
- Annual subs are discounted for new club members joining during the year:
 - 50% off for new members joining from 1 April to 31 July
 - 75% off for new members joining from 1 August to 30 September
