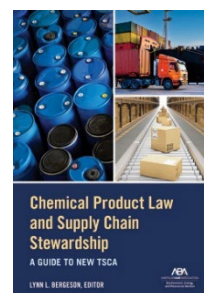


TSCA Reform – Nine Years Later, June 25, 2025, via livestream
