Using FYB Law2CM provides the following benefits:

- Automatic transfer of information and documents from Lawcadia into Content Manager with the right folder structure to meet internal requirements
- Ensures your organisation is meeting its record keeping compliance requirements for the storage and management of documents and records within Content Manager
- Reduces the duplication of information stored in multiple places, increasing data integrity and providing efficiencies to users for the retrieval of information
- Accessing documentation stored in Content Manager directly from the Lawcadia platform



What is Lawcadia?

Lawcadia is a cloud-based platform that in-house legal teams and their law firms use for matter management, legal intake & triage and legal spend management.

What is Content Manager?

The Content Manager solution is a governance-based enterprise content document and records management system designed to help organisations manage their business content from creation to disposal.

Version 2.0.X Features

- Automated creation of matter (case) folders in Content Manager with access controls set to reflect the Matter Permissions in Lawcadia
- Automated creation of matter sub folder structure
- Automated transfer of documents from Lawcadia into relevant matter folders in Content Manager
- ▶ Create locations in Content Manager from client and contact information stored on Lawcadia
- Case documents stored in Content Manager will be visible/accessible within Lawcadia

Prerequisites

- Content Manager 10.x, 10.1x, 23.x
- Lawcadia
- Microsoft Internet Information Services (IIS) 10
- .NET Framework 4.7.2
- Access to Law2CM requires the user to have a valid Content Manager License
- A Lawcadia account with administrator access to Content Manager. This account must be able to connect to the Lawcadia API
- Account used to run the app pool will need to be an Active Directory/Domain account
- The web application will need to be HTTPS-protected and able to communicate with your Lawcadia instance
- ▶ Law2CM must be installed on a Content Manager workgroup server

 - Mozilla Firefox
 - Microsoft Edge
