Saturday 26th July

Greytown



A relaxed start to the morning with a delicious buffet breakfast. We then make our way back into Greytown where we have a full day of exploring what else the festival has to offer.

This morning we will stop in at **Cobblestones Museum**. Cobblestones Museum and Heritage Village is an immersive time capsule giving glimpses into the characters, lives and legends of Wairarapa's early history. Six Heritage NZ Cat 2 listed buildings: Church, Hastwell Stables, Wairarapa's first hospital and dispensary, school, woolshed, and Victorian cottage all provide a journey through an earlier era. Māori taonga displays tell their own stories as do farm machinery, horse-drawn transport, dairy and sawmilling industries show their role in Wairarapa's early development. We will have time to have a stop in the famous **Schoc chocolate shop** to shout yourself some scrumptious treats.

Following our Museum visit we will make our way to **The White Swan Country Hotel** for a delicious group lunch.

From here, you will have free time for the rest of the afternoon and evening to explore what else the festival has to offer.

This evening, we will be experiencing the **GRAND FINALE!** When evening falls, get ready for an unforgettable street party and Carnival parade – Wairarapa style! Watch the performers dance past – or if you're feeling inspired, jump in behind them and get your groove on! So to top off the month of magic, they're ending with a bang – fireworks will light up the sky at 7:45pm, launching from the Greytown School grounds, making Main St a perfect viewing spot. It's also your
