## DAY 1

Sunday 6th Sept

**Home - Perth**

If departing from Whanganui, meet at the Whanganui Racecourse for a 6:30am departure and travel to Palmerston North Airport to catch our **flight** to Auckland at 9:10am.

Once we arrive in Auckland we will transfer to Auckland International Airport and get set for our 12:35pm **flight** direct to Perth.

Wednesday 9th Sept

It is a short drive to spectacular **Conspicuous Cliffs** for some stunning views and yummy bakery lunch at the beach.

In the afternoon, dive deeper into the region's secrets with the **WOW Wilderness Eco Cruise** – a passionate and personal 2.5-hour tour led by a local legend, revealing the wonders of Walpole's waterways, hidden inlets, and unspoiled landscapes.

Afterward, enjoy free time to relax or explore the peaceful town of Walpole at your own pace — stroll along the waterfront, browse local shops, or simply unwind surrounded by nature.

In the evening, reconnect with the group for a **delicious dinner** at a local restaurant.

Round off the day with a **group dinner** at Due South, a waterfront venue in Albany known for its locally sourced menu and panoramic harbor views.

### 1. Reservations & Payments

For all overnight or longer tours, a deposit as stated in the itinerary and is payable to secure the booking. The balance must be paid in full by the declared date in this itinerary.

Any customer who has booked a package with Take it Easy Tours shall not assign, purport to assign, or attempt to re-sell the package (whether whole or in part), rights or interests under these Terms without prior consent from Take it Easy Tours.

Any reservation made within six (6) weeks of the tour departure must be paid in full.

### 2. Medical

Please notify us of significant medical issues when you are considering making a booking so that we can inform you of any potential risks that may present themselves as part of the tour. Take it Easy Tours reserves the right to decline/refuse a booking because of medical concerns.

### 3. Health & Fitness

At Take it Easy Tours we pride ourselves on giving personal service to our customers. However, our guides are not qualified to provide individuals, who are not of reasonable, able-bodied health, the special time and attention they may need to make their tour a memorable experience. We're very happy for you to join us if you have a caregiver that can accompany you and provide help to you along the way.

### 4. Behaviour

Take it Easy Tours is not a common carrier and therefore reserves the right to refuse to carry or admit a person whose behaviour is considered detrimental to the enjoyment of the group. By travelling with Take it Easy Tours the traveller agrees to accept the authority of Take it Easy Tours staff leading the tour and accept their decisions. Our staff are entitled to a safe working environment and our passengers to a great holiday. Any threats to safety, either physical or verbal, or inappropriate behaviour by a passenger may result in their removal from the tour. If



staff require a passenger to leave a tour, no refunds will be given and the passenger will be responsible for their own travel costs from that point.

## **5. Travel Insurance – ask us for a quote with CoverMore**

In association with Cover-More Travel Insurance we offer to members insurance against unforeseen events which may necessitate you cancelling your travel with Take it Easy Tours. This is part of a comprehensive cover policy. It will secure your refund in the event of you having to withdraw from a booking. We just need your date of birth in order to provide you with a quote. There is a \$25 excess, payable for each claimable event.

- Should you decide to make use of this insurance, it must be purchased at the time you make your booking and paid in full with your tour deposit.
- Insurance Terms and Conditions apply and will be attached to your Cover-More Travel Insurance schedule which will be forwarded to you following purchase. Please ensure you take time to read through the policy wording and make yourself familiar with the cover it offers.
- Activation of your Policy by way of claim is between you as the policy holder and Cover-More NZ Ltd.

## **6. Cancellations and Refunds**

### **With Travel Insurance:**

Should you be forced to cancel your travel with us due to a claimable unforeseen event, Bay Tours will calculate the level of direct refund we are able to make to you. You then simply complete a Cover-More claim form for the difference between the Bay Tours refund and the amount you paid for the tour. Once approved, Cover-More will reimburse you less the \$25 excess.

### **Without Travel Insurance:**

Cancellation fees without Travel Insurance with us are as follows;

### **Multi-Day Tours:**

45 Days or more prior to commencement of the tour:

Full refund, less any non-recoverable payments to suppliers of the tour eg flights, show tickets etc



44 to 22 Days prior to the commencement of the tour:  
100% loss of deposit paid.

21 Days or less prior to the commencement of a tour:  
100% loss of tour price paid.

If you cancel at any time, and following discussion with Take it Easy Tours, you are able to get someone to take your place, you will receive a refund of the amount paid, less an admin fee of \$250 and any non-transferable payments to suppliers e.g flights

We strongly encourage the purchase of Travel Insurance in order to provide peace of mind that the full amount paid is protected (as per item 5 above).

## **7. Itinerary Variations**
