

Preschool Tuition & Income Level Guide

2026 Summer School & 2026–27 School Year



City Garden's Preschool Program is tuition-based, with tuition tied to your family's household size and income. This guide walks you through both steps: first find your Income Level, then look up your potential tuition rate for the regular school year and Summer School 2026. All applicants seeking any Income Level other than D must apply for financial aid.

Step 1: Find Your Income Level

Use the chart below to determine your Income Level. Match your household size to your annual household income to find whether your family falls into Income Level A, B, C, or D, with A being the lowest and D the highest.

Step 2: Find Your Tuition Rate

Now that you know your potential Income Level from Step 1, use the tables below to find your potential monthly tuition for the regular school year (August–May) and for Summer School 2026 (a four-week session), by program type and Income Level.

Good to Know

- Paying monthly costs the same as paying for the year up front — for the regular school year, 9 monthly payments (Aug–April) add up to the exact annual rate, with no added fee for spreading out payments.
- Booking all four weeks of Summer School at once offers a small savings over paying week by week for most income levels.
- Income Levels A–D are assigned using the Income Level Calculator on the Admissions page — Level A reflects the lowest tuition rate and Level D the highest. All applicants seeking any Income Level other than D must apply for financial aid.
- A deposit is required to secure your spot in the program. The deposit is applied to the last month of tuition costs for the school year.
