Backcountry Skiing

*Expert skiers only (preferably with backcountry experience). You should have a backpack, shovel, avalanche beacon and preferably have completed level one avalanche rescue course. Rentals available at the rental center.

All Day Ski Guides

Excursions

Full Day Snowmobile Excursion

8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. Meet in the Hotel Terra lobby

This trip is designed for all levels of snowmobilers. Your Guide will take you through the beautiful Bridger Teton National Forest on some of the over 600 miles of groomed trails. We will stop for lunch at Brooks Lake Lodge or Turpin Meadows Ranch. Total time is 8 hours from pick up to drop off and 6 hours on the trails. Snowsuit, boots, and helmets are provided. We recommend you dress in warm layers and bring sunglasses/goggles, gloves and balaclava. Transportation to/from the Jackson Hole area is included. The Summit provides an 18% gratuity to the guides. You may provide additional gratuity at your discretion.

Snowshoe Excursion

8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. Meet in the Hotel Terra Lobby

This unique expedition combines wildlife viewing with a snowshoe tour through Grand Teton National Park. Be sure to wear warm, sturdy hiking boots and dress as you would for skiing: coat, snow pants, gloves, hat, etc. National Park pass fees and gratuity included.

Dogsledding Experience

Times vary. Meet your guides at the Dogsled hut in front of Snake River Lodge

Just a short walk from the Hotel Terra lobby, you can hop on a sled that will be pulled by a team of Alaskan Huskies and driven by qualified guides! Your sled can accommodate 1-2 adults (max weight 400 lbs). You'll start off by gliding through a small wooded section on a private groomed trail, and pop out into an open meadow along the base of the Teton range. Along the ride there will be photo opportunities and, conditions permitting, you may get to stand on the back with the guide. Participants must be able to sit upright, stand, and walk unassisted.

National Elk Refuge Sleigh Ride

Times vary. Meet in the Hotel Terra lobby

Climb into a horse drawn sleigh that takes you for a ride onto the National Elk Refuge. You will find yourself in the middle of a western adventure unlike any other. As you venture across the Refuge to the sounds of snow crunching beneath the horses' feet, you will encounter sights that can only be found on the National Elk Refuge. Round-trip transportation from the hotel to Downtown Jackson and gratuity are included. The sleigh ride is about 45 minutes to an hour. Please dress very warmly.

Experience Downtown Jackson Hole

(On your own)

A popular tourist destination and a gateway city to two of the United State's most scenic national parks, the town of Jackson is located in a valley, commonly known as Jackson Hole. With its wooden sidewalks, saloons, and cowboy feel, it truly is a scene out of the Wild West. Ask the concierge to arrange transportation to Jackson where you can shop, explore and grab some lunch in one of the many eateries. Be sure to dress warm for walking around outdoors.
