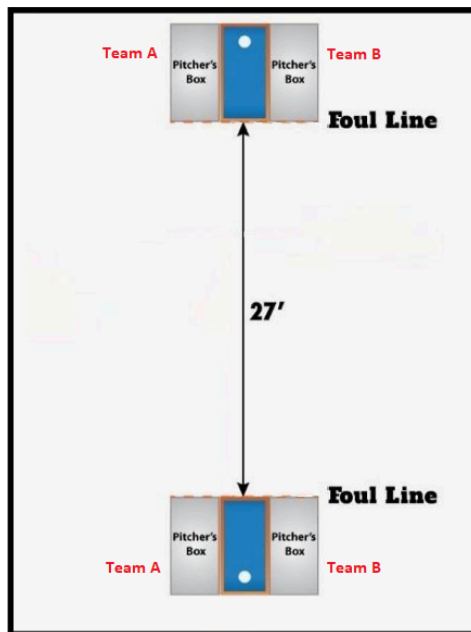


Cornhole for Charity Tournament Rules

1. Court Layout

- **Tournament Bags:** Bags will be provided at the tournament. No outside bags will be allowed.
- **Boards:** The boards are positioned 27 feet apart, measured from the front edge of each board.
- **Foul Line:** The front edge of the cornhole board is the foul line



2. Method of Scoring

- Bags in the hole are worth 3 points
- Bags on the board are worth 1 point
- A bag on the ground or one that touches the ground during the throw is worth 0 points.
- Cancellation Scoring- Points from one team are subtracted from the other, so only one team scores per round. For example, if Team A scores 9 points in a round and Team B scores 5 points in the same round, the 5 points are "cancelled" from the 9 points leaving Team A with 4 points for that round.

3. Length of Games

- Traditional 21: The first team to reach or exceed 21 is the winner.
- **NO BUST RULE**

4. Overview of Play

- Roshambo (Rock-Paper-Scissors) will be used to determine which team pitches first. The winner of Roshambo will decide if their team or the opposing team will pitch first.
- Team A competes against Team B – each team is comprised of two (2) people.
- Each team will stay in their designated pitchers' box for the entirety of the game.
- Opposing players on the same side of the board will alternate pitching bags until each player has pitched all (4) of their bags.
- The team that scores in a round will pitch first in the next round
- If neither team scores, the team who pitched first in the preceding round shall retain first pitch in the next round.
- A player must pitch all (4) cornhole bags from their designated pitcher's box.
