What is IIC?

Imperial International College (IIC) is an online learning institution that offers comprehensive support to students wishing to write their International GCSE and AS-Level qualifications. Although we are not a registered Cambridge center, our courses are all aligned to their syllabi and fully prepare students for their final International GCSE and AS-Level examinations.

We were originally birthed out of Love2Learn, which offers a homeschooling curriculum up to Grade 9. in order to offer students a way to receive a recognised qualification that would grant them access to tertiary institutions.

IIC has been offering online tutor support to both local and international students since 2013.

What subjects can students take and how long are IIC's courses?

We currently offer 13 International GCSE subjects and 10 AS-Level subjects, which you can view on our website here: <https://iic-online.com/iic-subject-list/>

Both our International GCSE (Gr 10/11) and AS-Level (Gr 12) courses are either 12 months or 18 months long, depending on a student's academic background.

We have two intakes per year, one in January and another in July. This is possible as the International GCSE and AS-Level examinations are held worldwide in May/June every year and also in October/November every year.

Where do students write exams?

One of the many attractions of the International GCSE and AS-Level Qualification for which we offer support is that they may be written almost anywhere in the world, either at registered schools that accept private candidates or through British Council offices. So although I.I.C. is not yet a registered examination centre (Due to our being a 100% online/distance learning institution) you should be able to write your exams wherever you are based. I.I.C. provides its students with the necessary exam registration information when registration opens.

As long as any of the registered schools in your area that offer these exams accept independent candidates or the British Council office in your city is a registered examination centre and offers the International GCSE and AS-Level exams – you will be able to study through I.I.C. and register to write your exams via your chosen centre.

What is the learning environment like?

Our courses are all offered online via the MyCollege Online Platform. That being said – every subject has a set of textbooks. The platform guides students on what to study, but most of their learning is done in their books.

Further to the lesson plans and timetables found on the platform, students also gain access to a host of essential features like designated Tutors for each subject, ongoing assessment & feedback, video lessons, interactive activities and more.

Will students receive a recognised qualification if they complete their Cambridge International GCSE's and AS-Levels?

Yes! The Cambridge International GCSE and AS-Level qualifications are recognized by tertiary institutions worldwide, and students can apply to universities both locally and internationally, depending on their subject choices and final results for their exams.
