Children receive instruction to steer their learning journey in the right direction.

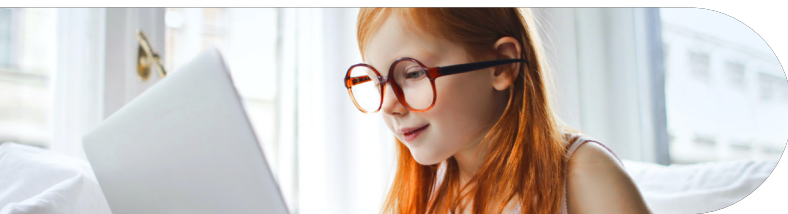


Learning at their own pace

Please note: your child must be at least four years old to be registered for Grade R and must turn five or older by at least 30 June of their Grade R year.



In Grades 1 – 3, we focus on four compulsory subjects:

- At least one Home Language (English or Afrikaans)
- A First Additional Language (English, Afrikaans, or isiZulu)
- Mathematics
- Life Skills

Please note: your child must be registered for Grade 1 in the year that they turn seven.

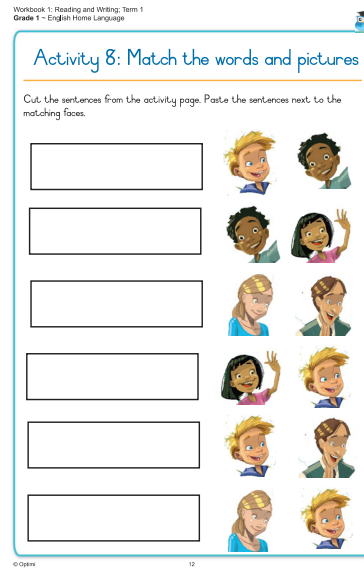
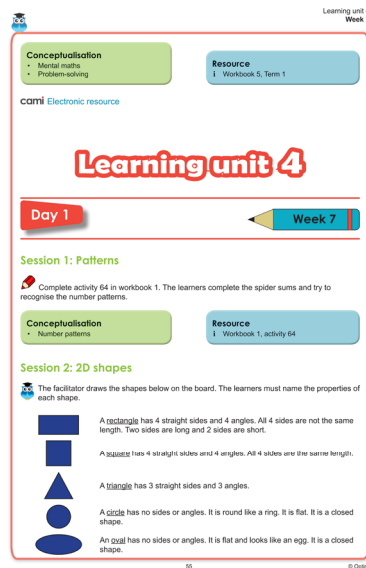

Assessments in the Foundation Phase

In Grade R:

It is not compulsory for Grade R learners to complete any formal assessments. Nonetheless, Impaq will provide all the formal assessment components you need if you want to monitor your child's progress.

In Grades 1 – 3:

You will receive all the formal assessment components and memorandums required to assess your child at home easily. If you do not want to mark the assessments yourself, you have two other options, namely:

- Asking a qualified teacher or tutor to assist. Impaq supports independent tutors throughout the country who make use of our products and services. They can help you with administrative and educational tasks. See a list of tutors on our website (www.impaq.co.za).
- Sending the formal worksheets to Impaq. We will mark the assessments for you. Do note that you will still have to do the oral tasks with your child as Impaq does not mark oral tasks in the Foundation Phase.

Learners in Grades 1 – 3 must complete the formal assessments before they can move on to the next grade.
