Vendor fee is \$8.00 per 6-foot table. Fees can be paid by check made out to 'CACGA'; by credit card through the Center's online gift shop at www.artsglenallen.com; or in-person at the Center's front desk. Tables will be sold first-come, first-served until vendor space is sold out. Booth fees are non-refundable.

Please note:

- Vendors provide their own methods of payment, including cash for change. The Center will
 not be able to provide change.
- While tables and a chair are provided by the Center, all other display materials are the responsibility of the vendor.
- Vendors are welcome to barter or negotiate prices as they see fit.
- Items not related to art and craft making are not allowed. All items must be considered
 material for creative inspiration (artwork, supplies, books about art or creative processes,
 sketchbooks, tools, etc.) or may be finished products the maker wishes to clear out at yard
 sale prices. Vendors who include items not related to making will be asked to remove them.
 No refunds will be offered to vendors whose products are not acceptable.
- Finished handmade items may be sold, but this is not an arts market. Finished projects offered should be sold at yard sale prices. This event is perfect for selling older pieces that haven't found a home or to sell imperfect pieces. Otherwise, the focus of this event is to sell materials and supplies.
- All UNSOLD items must be removed by the seller or seller may consider donating unsold items with instructional value to the Cultural Arts Center for use in their Outreach programs.
 A list of preferred donations will be shared with vendors in advance for consideration. A designated area for donations will be assigned at the end of the event.
- Vendors must provide shopping bags for their customers.
- Vendors are also encouraged to share photos of some of the items they will have for sale to help with marketing and promotion of the event.
