Why the training matters	The FSR Code requires cell site analysis used in evidential material to be presented as expert evidence, including opinion on the meaning of the data in the context of the case. Yet cell site findings are still frequently presented as maps, tables or Cell IDs and treated as “fact” evidence, an approach that is non-compliant and poses significant evidential risk. If Call Data Records are used to infer where a device may have been, forensic inference is required, and opinion must be given by a competent expert.	Who the training is for	The course is well suited to: • Law Enforcement Agencies delivering, or intending to deliver, cell site evidence at court • Units transitioning from investigative use of cell site analysis to evidential application • Organisations working towards accreditation • Analysts, managers and leaders with responsibility for evidential standards and risk
What the training provides	This course provides a grounding in the Case Assessment and Interpretation (CAI) model, tailored specifically to cell site analysis and aligned with the FSR Code and DIG200. The course focuses on how opinion evidence should be formed, evaluated and expressed when cell site analysis moves from investigative use to evidential use. This is not a technical interpretation or tooling course. It addresses the forensic reasoning and evidential standards required for court.
