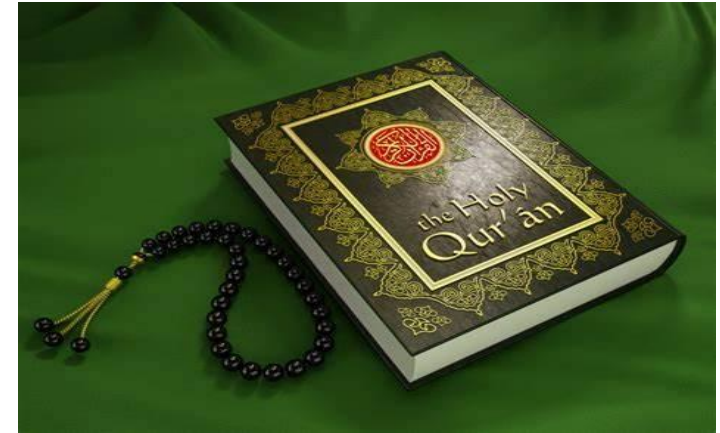

### Year 6 Knowledge Organiser: What is important to Muslims?

VOCABULARY	
<b>Islam</b>	The religion of Muslims.
<b>Muslim</b>	A follower of the religion of Islam.
<b>Five Pillars</b>	The five obligations that every Muslim must satisfy in order to live a good and responsible life.
<b>Foundations</b>	Underlying basis or principle.
<b>Arabic</b>	A language of the Arabs, spoken by some 150 million people throughout the Middle East and North Africa. The Qur'an was first revealed in Arabic.
<b>Qur'an</b>	The sacred text of Islam.
<b>Mosque</b>	A Muslim place of worship.
<b>Allah</b>	God in Arabic.
<b>Muhammad (PBUH – Peace Be Upon Him)</b>	Prophet (messenger) and founder of Islam.
<b>Shahadah</b>	Pillar 1 - The belief in Allah and Muhammad as his messenger.
<b>Monotheistic</b>	The belief that there is only one God.
<b>Prophet</b>	In religion, a prophet is said to be in contact with a divine being.
<b>Salah</b>	Pillar 2 – Prayer
<b>Mecca</b>	The birthplace of Muhammad (PBUH) in Saudi Arabia.
<b>Kaaba</b>	A cubed in the court of the <a href="#">Great Mosque</a> at Mecca.
<b>Wudu</b>	The act of washing certain body parts before prayer.
<b>Zakat</b>	Pillar 3 – Charity of 2.5% of wealth which Muslims should pay.

<b>Sawm</b>	Pillar 4 - The Arabic word for fasting.
<b>Ramadan</b>	The holy ninth month of the Islamic calendar, during which time Muslims refrain from eating or drinking during sunrise.
<b>Eid-el-Fitr</b>	A festival which marks the end of the month long period of Ramadan.
<b>Hajj</b>	Pillar 5 - A pilgrimage which takes place annually to the holy city of Mecca; Muslims try to carry out at least once in their lifetime.
<b>Pilgrimage</b>	A journey made to a sacred place or a religious journey.
<b>Ismail</b>	Regarded as a prophet in Islam and an ancestor of Muhammad. He helped his father build the Kaaba.
<b>Hagar</b>	Wife of the prophet Abraham. She gave birth to his first son Ismail
<b>Surah</b>	A verse in the Qur'an.
<b>Islamophobia</b>	Dislike or prejudice against Muslims or Islam.
