









<div><div>Blitz</div><div>A shortened version of the German word Blitzkrieg, meaning “lightening war.” Used to describe the bombing of British cities.</div></div>	<div><div></div><div>Germany invades Poland and Britian declares war</div><div>Battle of Britian</div><div>Blitz</div><div>D-Day</div><div>Germany surrenders</div><div>Hitler comes to power in Germany</div><div>Churchill becomes Prime Minister</div><div>USA enters the war after Japan bombs Pearl Harbour</div><div>Japan surrenders</div></div>	<div><div></div><div>Anderson Shelter</div></div>
<div><div>Air Raid</div><div>An attack in which bombs are dropped from aircraft on to a ground target.</div></div>		<div><div></div><div>Soldiers at War</div></div>

<div><div>Rationing</div><div>Putting a limit on things such as food and clothes that people can buy so everyone has a fair share.</div></div>		
<div><div>Reparations</div><div>The action of making amends for a wrong that has been done, usually by providing payment.</div></div>		
<div><div>Conscripted</div><div>When someone is told by their country they have to fight.</div></div>		
<div><div>Women's Land Army</div><div>A British organization created so women could replace men called up to the military.</div></div>
