Homework Expectations -In History, Re, Geography and Science we have Knowledge Organisers for all subjects. These can be accessed through the school website -click on Our School and then Our Curriculum. The children can use their Knowledge Organisers to be a teacher for you ... or maybe you could quiz them on the vocabulary learned so far in a term. Our home reading expectation is that pupils will read a minimum of four times a week. The children also have termly spelling lists to learn and maths fact sheets—CURFS to learn.
