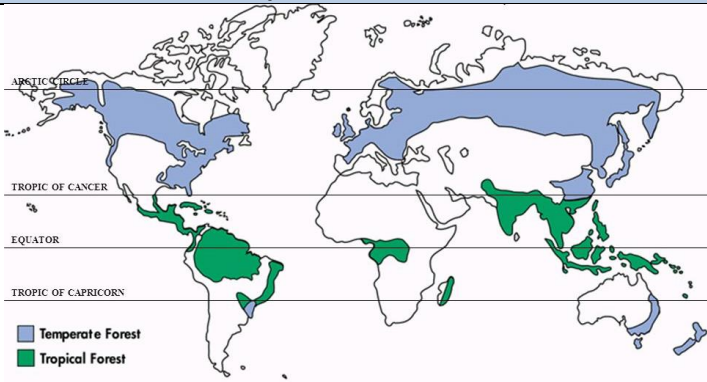


Why is the rainforest important to me? – Knowledge Organiser - Year 4 Autumn 2

Vocabulary		Map showing the location of the world's tropical and temperate rainforests.		Benefits of the rainforest on people
Rainforest	A dense forest, normally found in tropical areas with high rainfall. They generate much of the world's oxygen.			• Provide medicines (nearly three-quarters of plants that can actively fight diseases are found in the rainforest). • Provide food (80% of world's diet originated from rainforest plants). • Support indigenous tribes to have homes and food. • Production of palm oil (contained in thousands of supermarket products). • Produce useful materials such as rubber, wood and fabric. • More cattle can be raised on rainforest land meaning more beef and leather is produced.
Biome	Large area of the planet with similar climate, landscapes, plants and animals.			
Tropics	Parts of the world that lie between two lines of latitude, the Tropic of Cancer and the Tropic of Capricorn.			
Temperate	A climate or place with mild temperatures and moderate rainfall.			
Indigenous	Originating from or happening naturally in a place.	Deforestation		Benefits of the rainforest on people • Keep Earth's weather under control – create rainfall and lower temperatures • Provide a home to many species of animals and plants • Trees reduce carbon dioxide and help prevent global warming and climate change. • Help maintain the water cycle for the whole planet • Reduce damage from flooding by controlling water held in soil.
