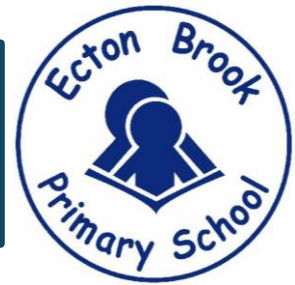


Key Instant Recall Facts

12	×	8	=	96

8	÷	8	=	1
16	÷	8	=	2
24	÷	8	=	3
32	÷	8	=	4
40	÷	8	=	5
48	÷	8	=	6
56	÷	8	=	7
64	÷	8	=	8
72	÷	8	=	9
80	÷	8	=	10
88	÷	8	=	11
96	÷	8	=	12

Example Questions

What are 6 groups/lots of 8?

How many 8s are there in 56?

What is 16 divided by 8?

Activity Suggestions

Sound patterns – say the times tables out loud (1 times 8 is 8, 2 times 8 is 16 etc.)

Songs – there are lots of songs online that help children to learn times tables. You could challenge your child to make up one of their own.
