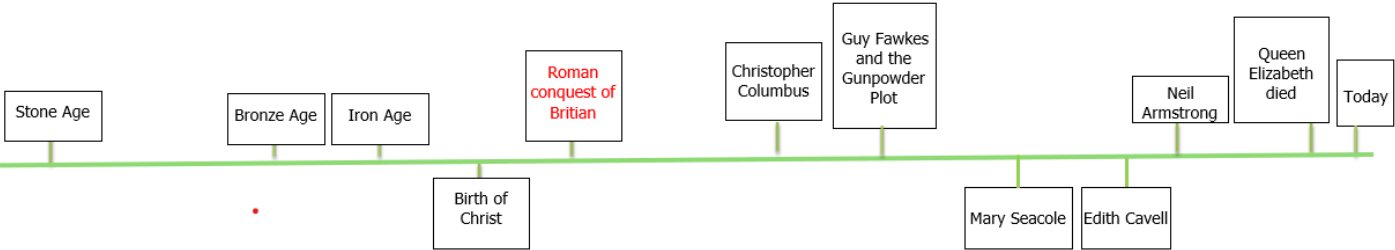

Timeline



Vocabulary

Invade	to enter a place by force.
Empire	a group of countries ruled by the government or ruler of one particular country.
Conquer	to take complete control of a place or people.
Barbarian	a person who lived outside the Roman Empire, seen by the Romans as violent.
Revolt	to take violent action against a ruler.
Emperor	a man who rules an empire or is the head of state in an empire.
Villa	a fairly large house.
Tribe	a group of people who are linked together and often led by a strong leader.
Britons	The people who lived in Britian before the Romans

Did you know?

- ✓ The calendar we use today is based on the Roman Calendar, and some of our months are names after Roman gods or rulers.
- ✓ The Romans were famous for their amazing feasts!
- ✓ The Romans didn't have soap. Instead they covered their bodies with oil and scraped it off with a curved metal toil called a strigil.

Important People

Julius Ceasar	Ordered the invasion of Britain and failed.
Boudicca	Celtic Queen of East Anglia who revolted against Rome.
Emperor Claudius	Emperor who ordered the invasion and conquest of Britain and succeeded.

The Romans conquer Britain



The Romans had three attempts at Invading Britian: 55-54 BC, AD40 and AD43.

Even though they were outnumbered by the Britons, such as Boudicca's warriors, The Romans were better trained and had better armour. Both sides clashed in fierce battles, but The Romans eventually won.
