


How is Northampton different to Chembakolli? Knowledge Organiser Year 2 Spring 2

Vocabulary	
Town	A place with many streets and buildings where people live and work. It is bigger than a village and smaller than a city.
Village	a group of houses and other buildings that is smaller than a town, usually in the countryside.
Equator	an imaginary line around the middle of the earth.
Weather	the conditions outside at a particular place and time.
Monsoon	a strong wind that brings lots of rain.
Rural area	there are fewer houses and people, and lots of open space like farms, fields, and forests
Urban area	populated with many more buildings and people
