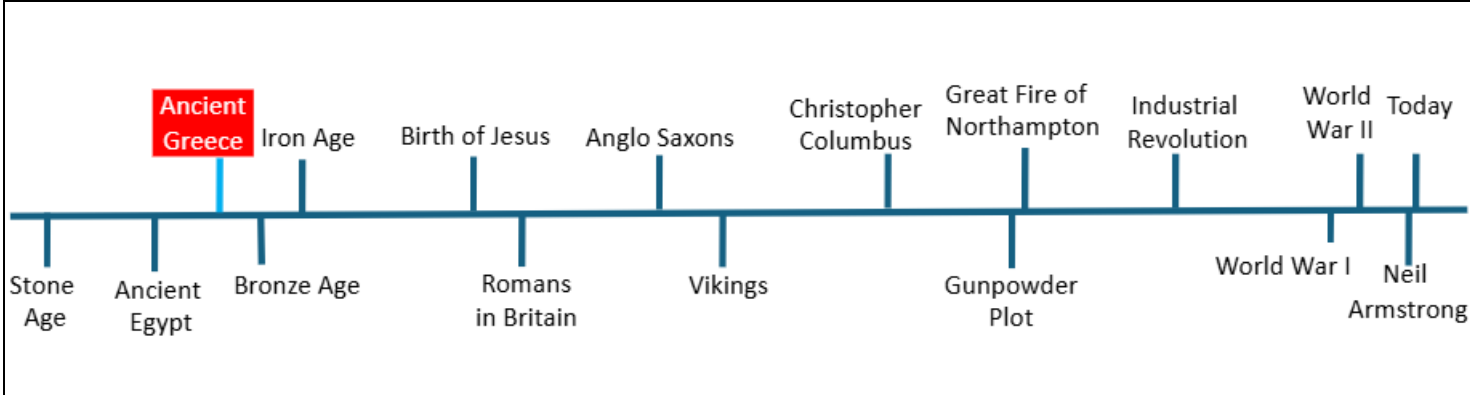

Vocabulary

Conquer	To overcome or gain control by force.
Polytheistic	Religious system where people believe in or worship more than one god.
Colony	A settlement which is under the control of your home country.
Scholar	A person who through deep study has gained mastery in subjects.
dissolution	When a form of leadership comes to an end.
pentathlon	A sporting contest with 5 specific events.
philosopher	Someone who studies the nature of life, truth and knowledge.
City-State	A self-governing state made up of a city and surrounding territory.
patron	a person who gives financial or other support to a person.
morphology	The shape or form of something.

The Olympian Gods



The Olympians Gods are:

Zeus (King of all the Gods), Artemis (Moon Goddess), Hera (Queen of the Gods), Poseidon (God of the sea), Hestia (Goddess of the hearth), Aphrodite (Goddess of love), Ares (God of war), Demeter (Goddess of plants), Apollo (Sun God), Athena (Goddess of wisdom and war), Hermes (Messenger of the Gods), Hephaestus (God of blacksmiths)
