Year 6 Residential visit to Longtown **21st September to 25th September 2026**

In order to give you plenty of time to ensure that the necessary items are to hand, we are writing to inform you of the clothing and other equipment your child will need for the visit to Longtown.

Although all food is provided by the centre, your child will need to bring a packed lunch and drink for the Monday.

Specialist equipment and clothing is provided by the Centre, but your child will need to be kitted out to cope with all conditions. They do not need school uniform. They will not need any smart clothing – it is likely to get spoiled. Your child must **NOT** take their mobile phone or any electronic devices.

Your child will need:

Flat sheet and pillow case

Sleeping bag or duvet cover

Hard wearing trainers (old pair for outdoors)

Hat and gloves

9 x Underwear (vest, pants/knickers)

7 x T shirts (long and short sleeved)

Nightclothes

5 x Hoodies/fleeces

Warm waterproof coat

Socks – 5 x thick and long for inside boots and 5 x thin ones for when indoors

Washing kit (soap, flannel, toothpaste, shampoo, toothbrush, roll on deodorant – no sprays please)

2 x large bin liners to store wet or dirty clothes

Trainers for indoors - not slippers

Water bottle - named

Sun cream and hat in case of warm weather

7 x Trousers/tracksuit bottoms/leggings (no jeans)

2 x large towels

Swimming costume / trunks

Torch and batteries

We do recommend that you pack several changes of clothing, including spare underwear and socks as the children will get dirty and wet. **You should also name every item as unclaimed lost property will be disposed of once we have left the centre.**

Pocket Money

There will be very few, if any, opportunities to spend money. The centre has a small shop which sells souvenirs. No more than £5.00 should be brought in a clearly labelled purse/envelope and should be handed in on the day of departure.

The children can also bring a book to read, a cuddly toy and a small game (such as cards) that they will need to be responsible for.

Any outstanding money MUST be paid by Friday 3rd July 2026 via the Arbor app.

On the Monday morning, we will leave school at 8.30am and children need to be in school for 8.00am so that we can register them and load the coach.
