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General Local Law 2017

Rules for Street Collection Permit

This permit relies on the permit holder meeting all of these rules and any other statutory obligation associated with the activity.

- 1. Collectors for the appeal must be of a mature age, or have suitable supervision.
- 2. You must provide Council a copy of your public liability insurance..
- 3. Collectors must display the name of the organisation they are representing.
- 4. The organisation in charge of an "on road collection" must obtain the relevant approval of the Chief Commissioner of Police and comply with the *Road Safety (Traffic Management) Regulations 2009 Section 28*
- 5. The organisation must meet with the requirements of the Fundraising Act 1998
- 6. The activity must not restrict vehicle or pedestrian access and/or block access to entrances of any businesses.
- 7. Canvassing "hard sell" is not allowed.
- 8. Solicitation or collection will be properly and inoffensively conducted.
- 9. Representatives must carry a valid "hard copy" of the Council permit with them at all times.
- 10. Council reserves the right to change the conditions of issue and use of the permit at any time.
- 11. Representatives who break the "Conditions of Issue and Use" may be ineligible to get approval for fundraising activities for a period of twelve (12) months.
- 12. No more than two (2) representatives of the registered charity organisation are allowed to fundraise at any one location.
- 13. A registered charity organisation can apply for approval to fundraise at one (1) location on any two (2) days per calendar month per twelve (12) month period (01 July 30 June).
- 14. Fundraising activities are only allowed for the dates, times and location shown on the approval.
- 15. Council reserves the right to cancel the permit to fundraise or promote any group or charity that does not follow the rules at any time
- 16. Street collections are not allowed in the area of Council designated community raffle sites, which are located at:
