Documentation: Copy of final inspection certificate issued for building permit for pool or spa.

Form 23. Is a document issued in Victoria, Australia, by a registered building inspector or surveyor, certifying that a swimming pool or spa safety barrier meets the required safety standards. Pool and Spa safety barrier inspections are required every four (4) years.

Type of pool or spa definitions: A relocatable pool or spa is a pool or spa that is contained within a relocatable temporary compliant barrier. If it is located within a permanent barrier then it is a permanent pool or spa. All swimming pools and spas capable of containing water greater than 300mm (30cm) must have a compliant safety barrier to restrict access to the area, this includes inflatable pools and spas.
