



PRE-CLINICAL REQUIREMENTS



Emory University's School of Nursing Pre-Clinical Requirements

Clinical agencies may require students to complete additional compliance and/or credentialing requirements. Many of these pre-clinical requirements must be collected prior to matriculation as well and other requirements to be collected at the time clinical placements are assigned or secured. The School of Nursing will invite all students to complete background and drug screenings as well as provide access to our clinical onboarding system. Students may begin collecting only items within the prescribed times listed below.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Authorization for Release of Student Information	Signed consent form to be completed in the Clinical Onboarding System
<input type="checkbox"/>	BLS/CPR	Proof of the American Heart Association Basic Life Support CPR card OR CPR eCard only. The Red Cross or any other entity will not be accepted.
<input type="checkbox"/>	COVID-19	All health sciences students in the School of Nursing must be compliant with proof of CDC issued card or immunization record showing complete primary Covid vaccination of either 2 doses of Pfizer, Moderna, Novavax OR 1 dose of the Johnson/Jassen or proof of the bivalent dose of Pfizer or Moderna.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Criminal Background and Drug Screening	A criminal background investigation and drug screening is required before coming to campus. SON-Compliance will provide invitation to preferred vendor. No other proof will be accepted.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Health Insurance	Proof of current health insurance; military ID is not accepted.
<input type="checkbox"/>	HIPAA & Bloodborne Pathogen Modules	Proof of a Certificate of Completion to be completed upon Compliance Onboarding notification.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Influenza	Vaccination required by October 15 th of EACH year. Summer admits are not required to provide proof unless.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Nursing licensure	Proof of single state or multi-state/compact RN license. RN license must be valid in the State of Georgia as well as in the state(s) clinical rotations will be completed in. (Post- licensure students only) Renewable upon expiration every 2 years.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Post-licensure Clinical Placement Agreement	Signed agreement electronically completed (post-licensure students only) .
<input type="checkbox"/>	US Government Issued Identification	Proof of US government issued identification. Military ID will not be accepted. Renewable upon expiration.
