TEACHING AND MENTORSHIP

Teaching Specialization:

At Emory, I teach a total of three courses per academic year. Spanning pre- and post-licensure programs, I am Course Coordinator for a PhD-level class (NURS 794) entitled “Intersectionality and Health”. I am also co-lead of a pre-licensure course (NURS 514) regarding professional development and identity in nursing. My primary teaching responsibilities at the University of Miami were in the undergraduate Bachelor of Public Health (BPH) program, specifically BPH 321: Health Promotion and Disease Prevention and BPH 322: Introduction to Health Policy. I also co-taught an undergraduate elective BPH 499: Introduction to Global Health alongside University President Dr. Julio Frenk and Dr Felicia Knaul and serve as a clinical instructor for NUR 441: Public Health Nursing. These courses were taught using engaging pedagogical methods that encourage students to interact with current events and issues in the fields of health behavior, health policy, and global health. As a Global Health scholar, I also consulted on a course through the Global Women’s Institute at The George Washington University aimed at international development professionals. This course, called GenderPro, is the first attempt to professionalize the field of gender and development in low- and middle-income country settings. Paired with a credentialing exam of the same name, GenderPro aims to elevate the work of gender professionals working in the Global South. I also co-developed a graduate-level course in global women’s health at the University of Pennsylvania School of Nursing and guest lecture on violence research and theory, quantitative methods, and health equity at the undergraduate and graduate levels.
