2nd Reading: 1 Timothy 6:11—16

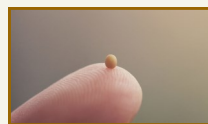
Paul exhorted Timothy to "pursue righteousness, devotion, faith, love, patience, and gentleness."
