JOB PURPOSE

- Manage and maintain all worship ministry systems, supplies, and equipment; ensuring that worship setup & tear down at gatherings is efficient and that worship environments are welcoming, safe, clean, and engaging for guests.

- Keep current in related field.
- Work with appropriate staff and volunteer leaders to carry out the ministry of Friends Church.
- Maintain a healthy balanced life spiritually, have spiritual mentors and prayer partners to care for you in your ministry and personal life.
- Attend and participate in all staff Friends Church staff meetings, events, programs, and training when available.
- Cooperate with supervision by performing appropriate related duties when assigned or instructed.
