Dear Friends and Partners,

As we celebrate 15 years of serving the world's most vulnerable children and families, I find myself pausing — not to count the milestones, but to feel the weight and wonder of this journey. Fifteen years of showing up. Fifteen years of your steadfast support. And so much more ahead.

In southern Haiti, where extreme poverty and food insecurity are daily realities, 2025 brought yet another blow when Hurricane Melissa swept through last summer. Through our partnership with the World Food Program, HRI reached thousands of children and families across seven communes with urgently needed food assistance — a partnership that continues into 2026, because hunger doesn't wait, and neither do we. As gang violence uprooted hundreds of thousands across Haiti, HRI also brought clean water to thousands of displaced families who had lost nearly everything.

In Guatemala, a grant from the Embassy of Japan allowed HRI to renovate school bathrooms in Quetzaltenango — restoring something harder to measure: dignity. Safe facilities keep children in school, and our nutrition programs ensure they arrive nourished and ready to learn. A child who is fed, cared for, and treated with dignity is a child who believes in her own future.

As 2025 closed, we were thrilled to finalize a new partnership with Fundación BI, bringing clean cookstoves to hundreds of Guatemalan families in 2026 — practical, hopeful work rooted in genuine partnership.

Fifteen years in, we are more convinced than ever that this work matters — because of you. Your generosity is the thread running through every meal delivered, every cup of water offered, every child who walks into a classroom nourished and ready. Thank you for walking this road with us. The best is still to come.

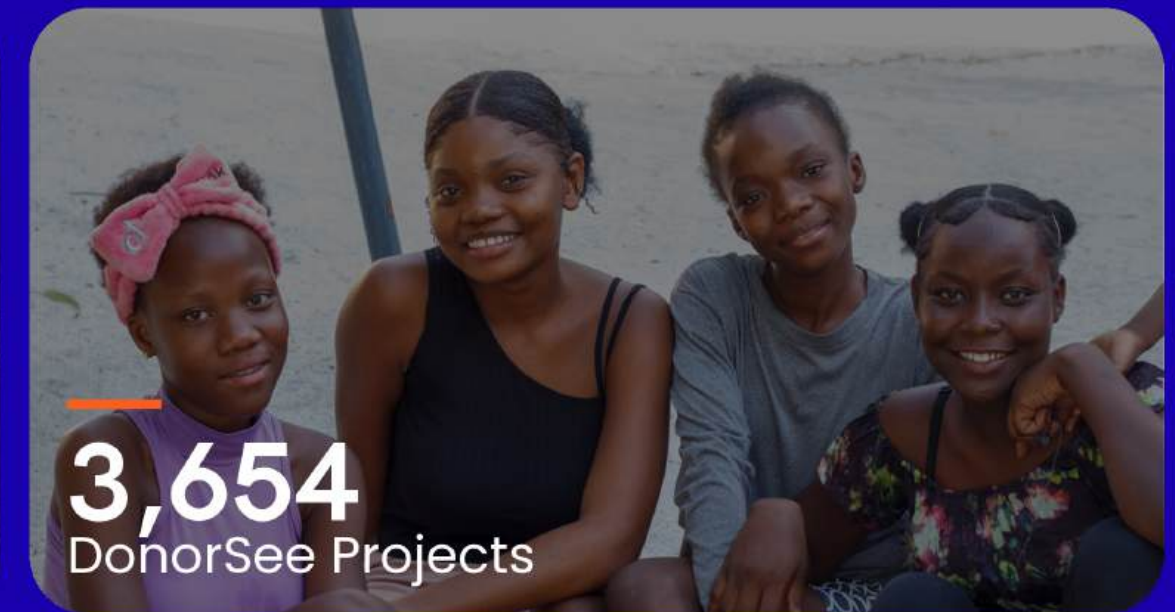
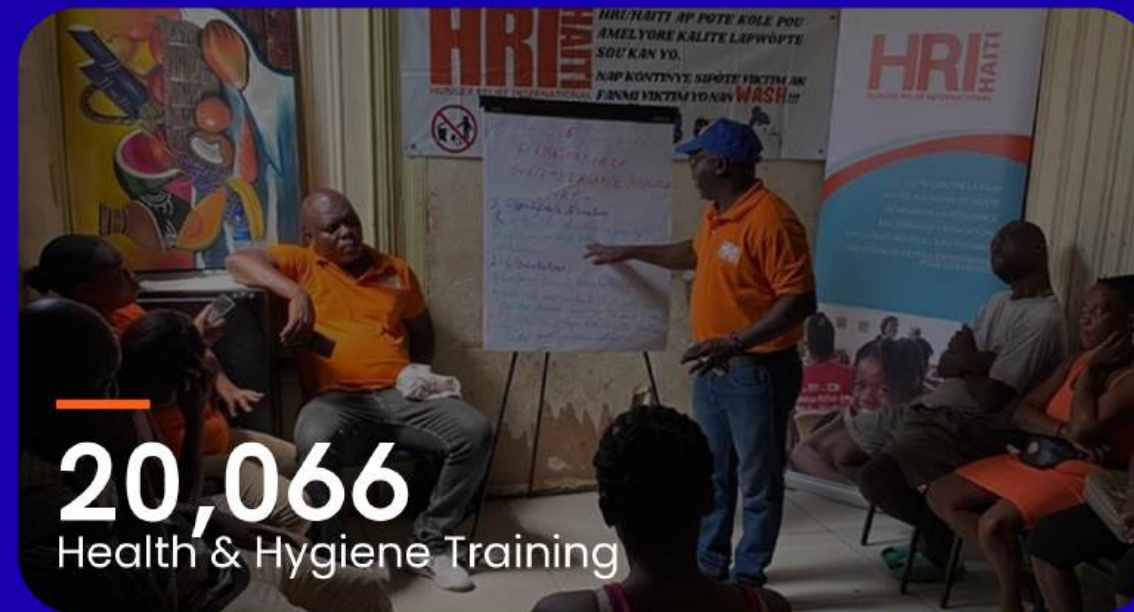

Lives Impacted Through HRI Programs in 2025



HRI Nutrition Programs

HRI is nourishing communities through evidence-based nutrition interventions that save lives, improve school attendance, and build healthier futures.

World Food Programme Partnership

Through our partnership with the WFP, HRI provided life-saving food assistance and nutrition support to 196,405 vulnerable children & families facing extreme hunger, poverty, and food insecurity—bringing hope and relief in their time of greatest need.

Supplemental Feeding for Orphans

HRI's orphan nutrition program provided consistent, nutritious meals to 379 vulnerable children and 72 caregivers in Haitian orphanages, bringing nourishment, stability, and hope while helping children grow healthy, stay in school, and thrive despite difficult circumstances.

School Feeding Programs

HRI's school feeding programs provided nutritious meals to 938 children in 9 vulnerable communities, helping ease the burden of hunger while improving school attendance, concentration, and opportunities for a brighter future in Guatemala.



HRI WASH Programs

Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene programs are foundational to community health and dignity and to help keep children - *especially girls* - in school.

Clean Water Access

HRI ensured 72,873 people had access to clean water by providing water filters, water truck deliveries, and emergency water pouches to orphanages, schools, vulnerable families, and displaced persons—bringing relief, dignity, and hope to communities in crisis.

Hygiene Kits & Education

HRI distributed hygiene kits to 4,922 people in orphanages, schools, and displaced persons sites, helping protect health, restore dignity, and support girls in staying in school, while providing health and hygiene trainings to 20,066 people.

Sanitation Services

Following Hurricane Melissa, HRI installed 8 showers for displaced families in Haiti. In Guatemala, HRI installed 8 toilets and 3 sinks in schools, helping restore dignity, improve hygiene, and provide safer facilities for 987 students during the school day.



HRI Education Programs

Education is the most powerful tool to break the cycle of poverty and create lasting change. Every child deserves the opportunity to learn, grow, and build a brighter future.

School Scholarships & Supplies

HRI provided school scholarships and/or school supplies to 299 children, helping remove barriers to education and equipping students with the tools, hope, and opportunity they need to learn, succeed, and remain in school.

Vocational Training

HRI supported 7 orphans in vocational training programs and provided ongoing support for one orphan pursuing a medical degree, helping vulnerable youth build skills, pursue their dreams, and create brighter, more sustainable futures.

Child Sponsorship

HRI supported 9 vulnerable children from single-parent households through the Children First Child Sponsorship Program by providing school scholarships, supplies, backpacks, shoes, uniforms, and essentials—helping children stay in school with hope for a brighter future.



HRI Medical Programs

Medical programs provide healthcare, maternal care, medical supplies, hygiene support, and access to treatment for vulnerable children and families, helping improve health, prevent disease, and restore hope.

Solar Panels for Health Clinics

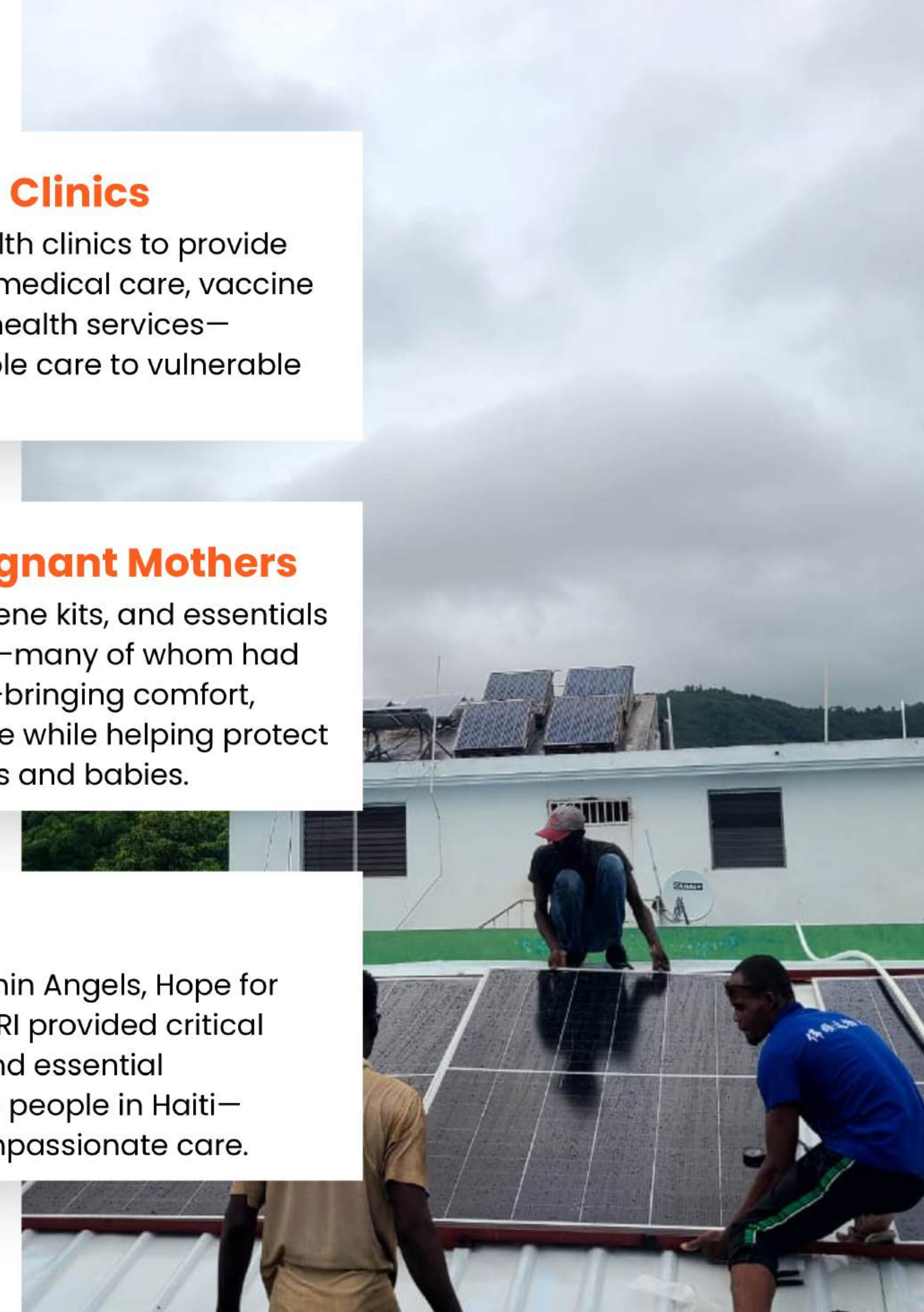
HRI installed solar panels at health clinics to provide reliable electricity for lifesaving medical care, vaccine storage, lighting, and essential health services—bringing hope, safety, and reliable care to vulnerable communities.

Care for Displaced Pregnant Mothers

HRI provided medical care, hygiene kits, and essentials to displaced pregnant mothers—many of whom had lost their husbands to violence—bringing comfort, dignity, and compassionate care while helping protect the health and safety of mothers and babies.

Medical Supplies

Through partnerships with Vitamin Angels, Hope for Haiti, and many health clinics, HRI provided critical medical care, health support, and essential interventions to 9,777 vulnerable people in Haiti—bringing hope, healing, and compassionate care.



Emergency Response

Hurricane Melissa Relief, Haiti

When Hurricane Melissa struck, HRI teams mobilized within hours, providing clean water, tarps, hygiene kits, disinfectant supplies, emergency food, showers, and more to 4,300 impacted people across multiple affected regions—bringing urgent relief, comfort, dignity, and hope to families during a devastating time of crisis.

Displaced Persons

Port-au-Prince, Haiti

HRI continued responding to the growing crisis in Port-au-Prince by serving 72,602 displaced persons with clean water, tarps, hygiene kits, WASH trainings, showers, medical care, and more—bringing relief, dignity, and compassionate support to families forced from their homes by violence and instability.

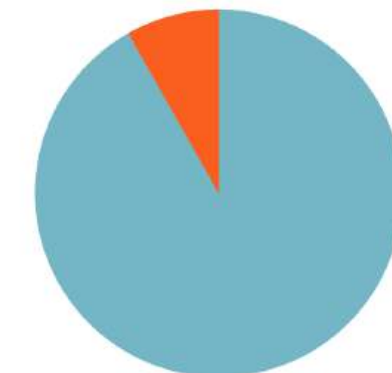
