

## **Outdoor Play Equipment Policy**

Playing and learning in an outdoor environment is vital to aid the physical development of young children and to encourage them to continue a healthy lifestyle as they continue their development into adulthood.

We encourage the children in our care to take part in a variety of physical activities and provide a range of resources to make it fun and enjoyable. This provides opportunity to develop physical skills, self-confidence, and coordination.

Alongside this development can be an element of risk taking which although promotes self-esteem needs to be managed carefully in order to keep the children safe. It is important for children to learn about danger and risk taking; however, in order to make the garden a safe place and to reduce the risk of possible accidents we have put the following procedures in place:

- All equipment will be used in line with the manufacturer's guidelines.
- Children will be taught how to use the equipment safely in a way that is appropriate for their stage of development and understanding.
- Children will be encouraged to take turns and share equipment.
- The equipment will be checked and cleaned before each use.
- The equipment will be monitored for wear and tear or damage in line with our risk assessments and withdrawn from use if faulty.
- Children will be encouraged to participate and will be provided with support but will not be made to do any activity that they are uncomfortable with.
