He's completed multiple degrees and had quite a bit of training, but it all started singing hymns and folk songs with his family. Sean made his NYC debut in Kinky Boots as the big and burly Don. Working with Cyndi Lauper might be the biggest highlight of his career! Sean can often be found in New York City singing at The Greenroom 42, 54 Below, and other cabaret clubs.
