Materials will be warm, efficient, and will communicate the RLC values. The structure is more than a gym; it is a statement of who we are and our leadership role in outdoor education and wellness.



The facility will reflect the needs of key stakeholders as identified through consultation with alumni, parents, and RLC faculty and staff. They have identified the need to:

- create a venue for sports and recreation while providing new opportunities for inter- and intra-school competition;
- create a centre for wellness as part of physical education;
- create a social hub, one where all students can meet informally outside of class time and in the evenings;
- enhance the entrance to the property and develop the property in a way that is distinctly RLC, honouring the traditions of the school and signalling our future;
- build relationships and partnership opportunities with community organizations.

The facility will include

- Outdoor seating/learning areas
- Reception area
- Team areas for gathering/learning
- Barrier free washrooms
- Media centre for announcements/teaching
- Universal shower/change rooms
- Sports courts with RLC Logo
 - Full size basketball court 94' by 50' with ceiling mounted nets
 - half basketball courts with nets on side walls
 - volleyball court
 - 4 badminton/pickleball courts
- Retractable bleachers



SPORTS-SPECIFIC TRAINING

From team competition to one-on-one coaching, the space allows for a broad range of activity and training. It sits across from the main athletics field, providing changing rooms and washrooms for visiting teams.



AN INCLUSIVE SPACE

Inviting and approachable, the facility promotes active lifestyles, wellbeing, teamwork, and fun. It's a place to train, but also to gather; a place to grow, but also to play. It provides a fully accessible social hub during the day and into the evenings.



A TEAM FACILITY

There are dedicated spaces for athletes and coaches to gather. Here, they'll review strategy and receive individual coaching. There are spaces for visiting teams, allowing RLC to host a wider range of athletic events and competitions year round.



A GATEWAY TO THE OUTDOORS

RLC is founded on the values and lessons of outdoor education. The vocabulary of the structure will be that of a facility that interfaces with outdoor education and recreation, serving as a gateway to the natural features of the campus.
