3. Where is God calling you to go out with him? What obstacle is challenging your faith?
4. Are you relying on your strength or God's strength? What areas of your life are you doing that well or poorly? What can help remind you of God's faithfulness and his help?

Read [1 Samuel 7:10-12](#)

5. When is a moment you saw God "thunder" in your life? Do you remember how you felt before and after?
6. Do you have an Ebenezer to remember God's faithfulness? How can you look forward to what he will do next?

Look Ahead:

What is the point in having Ebenezers? How do they help our faith journey for the future?

We often have battles to face. Sometimes it's battles we can't win on our own. It's important to remember or "Ebenezer" the times when God clearly comes through and saves us and gives us victory.
