To begin, click each image in the order listed below:

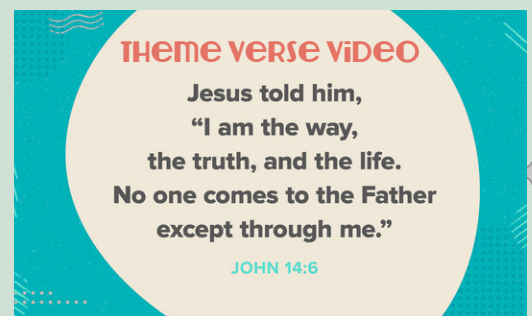
- **Image #1** - Watch the Big Idea video

## AHA I AM KNOWN

### DISCUSS & DISCOVER

1. Jesus told the woman who touched His clothes that her faith healed her. How do you think the woman felt when Jesus stopped to talk to her? *(Answers may include singled out, scared, embarrassed but relieved that she was healed, and so forth.)*
2. Jesus fully healed the woman in our Bible story, and she experienced an incredible miracle. We can also know about an even better miracle—the miracle of us being forgiven of our sin. How is being forgiven of our sin an even better miracle than being healed from a disease? *(Healing helps us know God is powerful, but God's forgiveness means we can have a relationship with God forever.)*
3. Can God see and know everyone in the world? How does our Bible story speak to the desire people have to be seen and recognized? *(God knows everyone. He loves people and wants them to know they stand out and matter to Him.)*

**Pray:** God, thank You for this time today! We love hearing from the Bible, and we have loved learning that You know everyone! Thank You for seeing us, knowing us, and loving us. Help us remember the truth that we are fully known by You. Amen.
