- 1. God gives the people who trust in Him some wonderful promises in these verses. He promises that we can find peace and satisfaction when we follow Him and that we find forgiveness when we turn to God. How do we get this new hope that God offers? (God gives us a new hope when we trust and follow Jesus.)
- 2. Not only does God give us a new hope when we trust and follow Jesus, but He also forgives all our sins. How can this hope of forgiveness help when we make wrong choices? What can we do when we make wrong choices? (God does not count any of our sins against those who trust in Him. He takes our sins away so we can have life with Him forever. When we make wrong choices, we can turn to God for forgiveness. When we trust in Jesus and ask for forgiveness, God forgives—forever.)
- 3. Having hope is easy when good things are happening but hard when life is difficult. What can help us remember our new hope when life is difficult? (We can pray or read our Bibles to remember the hope God gives us.)

Pray: God, thank You for the hope You give. Thank You that it will never go away or disappoint us. We can always count on You and hope in You because You are always faithful. Help us remember the hope You give us when life gets hard. Thank You for always being with us and for giving us life forever with You when we trust and follow Jesus. Amen.
