Discuss & Discover

- 1. This Bible story shows us our hearts need to be healed from sin. What happens when we trust in Jesus and He gives us new hearts? (God writes His name on our new hearts and helps us obey Him.)
- 2. When we trust in Jesus, God gives us a new heart, and He forgives all our sins. What changes when our sins are forgiven? (When we believe in Jesus, He forgives every sin we have ever done or will ever do, no matter how many or what kind of sins they are.)
- 3. This Bible story teaches that our hearts will lie to us, meaning we cannot always trust what we think and feel because of sin. However, God will always remind us of the truth when we turn to Him. How can we turn to God when we have thoughts and feelings that are not true or right? (Anwers may include: We can turn to God by praying and asking Him for help, reading the Bible and remembering what is true about God, and so forth.)

Pray: Jesus, thank You for giving Your life for ours so we could have a part in the new promise Jeremiah spoke about. God, thank You for making us totally new, forgiving our sins, and giving us new hearts when we trust in Jesus. Remind us You are the only One who can make our hearts right and that You want everyone to trust in Jesus and get new hearts. Amen.
