In our Bible Story, the Good Samaritan a man was hurt on the side of the road. Two people walked right by and didn't help. Of all the people in this story, they would be the ones that would likely help. They were respected in the community. They were very well known. They were the ones that taught others to serve. Instead they decided that this man in wasn't on their list of people they wanted to serve. But one man the Samaritan stopped, helped, and cared for him, even though they were very different in their upbringing. Jesus told that story to show us what it means to love our neighbor to serve and help others, no matter who they are.

DISCUSS & DISCOVER

1. **Who helped the man who was hurt on the side of the road?** *(The Good Samaritan helped him! He stopped, took care of the man's wounds, and made sure he had a safe place to stay.)* The Samaritan showed love through his actions — he praised God by serving someone in need.
2. **What does this story teach us about who our “neighbor” is?** *(Our “neighbor” isn’t just the people we like or who live near us it’s anyone who needs our help.)* Serving others is one way we show love to all our neighbors, just like Jesus taught.
3. **How can helping others be a way to praise God?** *(When we help and serve others, we show God’s love in real ways that makes Him happy and brings Him praise!)* Praising God isn’t only about singing or praying; it’s also about doing good things for others.

Pray: Dear God, Thank You for loving us so much and sending Jesus to show us how to serve others. Help us to have thankful hearts that want to help, share, and care for people—just like the Good Samaritan did. When we serve others, let it be our way of saying ‘Thank You’ for all You’ve done for us. We love You, Lord. In Jesus’ name, Amen.
