Discuss & Discover

- 1. What did the poor widow give at the temple? (She gave two small coins all the money she had.) Even though her gift was small, Jesus said it was worth more than what the rich people gave because she gave it with her whole heart.
- 2. Why was Jesus pleased with the widow's gift? (Because she gave out of love and trust in God, not to show off or get attention.) God looks at our hearts, not at how much we give. He cares about why we give.
- 3. **How has God been generous to us?** (He gives us everything we need life, family, friends, food, His love, and Jesus!) When we remember how much God gives us, it makes us want to share and help others too.

Pray: Dear God, Thank You for all the good things You've given us. Help us to have hearts like the widow thankful, trusting, and willing to give, even when we don't have much. Teach us to give and serve out of love, not to be seen, but to honor You. We're thankful for everything You've done for us through Jesus. In His name we pray, Amen.
