To begin, click each image in the order listed below:

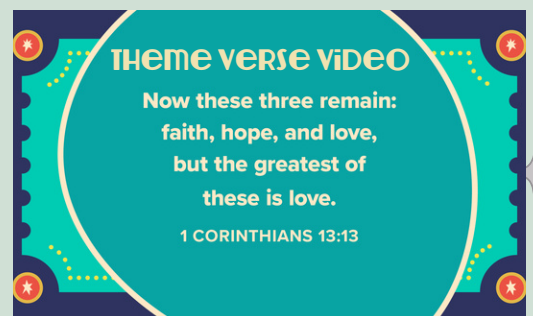
- **Image #1** - Watch the Big Idea video

Today's Bible story is in the book of 1 Corinthians. We will learn about a man named Paul who told a church in a city called Corinth about Jesus. He taught them about how God's love never ends.

DISCUSS & DISCOVER

1. Paul told the Corinthians in his letter that sin leads to death. However, through Jesus' death on a cross and His resurrection, we can have victory over sin and death! This means sin no longer separates us from God. When we believe in Jesus, we can enjoy a relationship with God filled with His love both now and forever. What is the difference between God's love and everything else in the world? (Answers will vary but may include how God's love lasts forever but nothing else lasts forever.)
2. Jesus is real, and He really did die on the cross and rise again. He did this because of His love that never gives up on us and lasts forever. How could you tell someone about God's never-ending love He shows through Jesus? (Answers will vary but may include that Jesus died and rose again, because God loves us and wanted to make the way for us to have a forever relationship with Him.)
3. Many people think that nothing lasts forever. However, the Bible tells us that God's love lasts forever! When people ask, "Does anything last forever?", what can our response be? (Yes! God's love lasts forever!) That is right! Who is someone in your life that you can tell this truth about God?

Pray: God, thank You that Your love never ends and never gives up on us. Thank You for sending Your Son, Jesus, to live a perfect life here on earth, die on a cross, and then rise again. Thank You for doing all of that, so that we can come to You and have freedom from sin. You love us so much, and that is truly the greatest love we could ever receive. Thank You for Your great love that has no end. Amen.
