

## ★ DISCUSS & DISCOVER

1. God's love is always faithful. Even though God gave the Israelites a choice to follow Him or not, He reminded them that He is always with them and they could always follow Him. We have a choice to follow God with our lives too! We can pray to God, read about Him in the Bible, and tell others about Him. What does it mean to follow someone? What are some ways can we follow God?
2. God always keeps His promises, and He has been faithful to show us His love forever through Jesus. We can believe that Jesus is who He says He is and really did what He said He would do through His life, death on the cross, and resurrection—when Jesus came back to life to defeat sin and death. How can we respond to God's faithful love shown to us through Jesus?
3. Things in our world change so quickly, and it is easy to ask ourselves if there is anything in life that never changes. However, the Bible tells us that God's love is faithful and never changes. How could today's Bible story help answer that question?
