To begin, click each image in the order listed below:


- **Image #1** - Watch the Big Idea video

DISCUSS & DISCOVER

1. In the Bible story, God said He would make a new promise with His people. He would forgive all their sins and write His laws on their hearts and minds. He would not actually write, like with a pencil. This meant that God would send the Holy Spirit to live inside His people to teach them, guide them, and change them. How can knowing that God sent Jesus and the Holy Spirit to fulfill this promise give you hope and help you trust and follow Him? (Tell kids that, when we trust and follow Jesus, we can always have hope, no matter what happens.)
2. What do you think changes in our lives when we trust and follow Jesus and know that we have a relationship with God forever? (Point out that we can thank God for giving life forever with Him to anyone who knows Him, and we can share this truth with others.)
3. Learning about history tells us that things in the world are different now than they used to be. How can it bring comfort to know that God is never different—that He has never changed and will never change? (Remind kids that we can have comfort in knowing that God is always loving, in control, and fulfilling His plans.)

Pray: God, thank You for never changing. Help us to remember Your faithful promises and take comfort in them. Thank You for making the way for us to know You by sending Jesus to die on a cross, rise again, and forgive our sin. Help us always to remember what You've done for us and be thankful that You made the way for us to know You. Amen.
