To begin, click each image in the order listed below:



- **Image #1** - Watch the Big Idea video

DISCUSS & DISCOVER

1. God placed a rainbow in the sky, saying He would look at every rainbow and remember His promise never to flood the whole earth again. God was just to send the flood because of the people's sin, and He was kind to save Noah and to send the rainbow. How can it bring you comfort to know that God is both just and kind? (Point out that we can trust God even when things do not seem right or fair because everything He does is just and kind.)
2. God punished people in our Bible story by sending a flood because they deserved it due to sin. We all deserve punishment because we have all sinned. The good news for us is that God sent Jesus to take the punishment we deserve because of our sin. How does God sending Jesus show that God is just and kind? (Tell kids that God sent Jesus to take the punishment for our sins.)
3. When things do not seem fair, how can it help to remember that God is both just and kind? (We can trust that God will always do what is right and will always do what is loving and helpful.)

Pray: God, thank You for always being just and kind. Thank You for giving us the Bible to help us know You. You showed You are just and kind by sending Jesus to take the punishment for our sins. Help us turn to You when life does not seem fair and know that You are just and kind, no matter what. Amen.
