To begin, click each image in the order listed below:



- **Image #1** - Watch the Big Idea video

Today our story comes from the book of Isaiah in the Old Testament, which is the first part of the Bible. Our Bible story focuses on a man named Isaiah, who knew and loved God.

DISCUSS & DISCOVER

1. In the Bible story, Isaiah realized that God is holy, meaning He is unique, perfect, and good. Isaiah saw the heavenly creatures praising and celebrating God by talking about His holiness and saying that His glory fills the whole earth. How can you celebrate God in your life?
2. Isaiah knew that He did not deserve to be in God's presence because of God's holiness, but God made a way for Isaiah to know Him and follow Him. How does God make the way for all of us to know Him and follow Him? (Point out that God sent Jesus, His only Son, to take our sins away. Remind kids that we can all know God and follow Him by trusting in Jesus.)
3. We all have a lot of special and unique things about every one of us. What does the Bible story show us about what makes us special? (Encourage kids that trusting in Jesus and being holy, like God is holy, is what makes someone really special.)

Pray: God, we are all meant to know You, and we thank You for that. Thank You for sending Your Son, Jesus, to make the way for us to know You. Thank You for making us holy like You are holy when we trust in Jesus. Help us point others to You as we live our daily lives. Amen.
