

EXAMINED COURSE REQUIREMENT

To follow a sixth form course of study candidates must meet the minimum requirements for one of the courses below, including English and Mathematics at grade 4 or above at GCSE. For this purpose, a GCSE in a modern foreign language which has been studied outside school and is the native language of the family may not normally be counted.

COURSE 1	Three A levels and an EPQ or an AS level in a modern foreign language (French, German, Italian or Spanish)	Candidates must have at least 3 GCSEs at grade 6 or above and a further three at grade 5 or above. The specific subject requirements below must also be met.
COURSE 2	Four A levels	Candidates must have at least 5 GCSEs at grade 8 or above and a further three at grade 7 or above. The specific subject requirements below must also be met.
COURSE 3	Four A levels and an EPQ	Candidates must have at least 5 GCSEs at grade 8 or above and a further three at grade 7 or above. The specific subject requirements below must also be met.

NON EXAMINED COURSE REQUIREMENT

In addition to the examined courses all sixth formers will follow the non-examined General RE Programme and, in addition, follow a course of PSHE. A contribution to co-curricular, academic extension, and community service programmes will also be expected. Participation in Games will be optional.
