# What We Do...



✱ We believe it is through living out and sharing our faith in Christ that we grow to be used by Him, love Him, serve Him and know Him. Each Wednesday night, during FFN (Family Faith Night) we gather in worshipping Jesus together... through fellowship, singing, lively skits, puppets and active learning. We also enjoy small group/classroom time, where we engage in Bible study, fellowship, sharing highs and lows, and prayer!

✱ The topics we learn about each Wednesday evening directly correlate with what Pastor Rob preaches during worship on the following Sunday. We encourage you to discuss these important Bible stories/faith topics at home and bring your children to worship to help further their faith growth!

✱ In addition to the material all the children will be learning in the "Opening Worship," of Family Faith Night, we have a specific focus for each class. First and foremost, each class grows in relationship with one another as they share highs and lows. Second, children grow in relationship with Jesus, as they learn different ways to pray and share prayer requests within their small group. Additionally, classes are each paired with a homebound friend (A Mission Partner who is unable to attend worship regularly), these pairings send craft projects, cards and reminders of Jesus' love to one another.

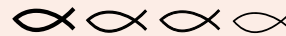


# Our Mission...
