Town Clerk Lorne Greene called the meeting to order at 1:00pm.

Lorne advised that the required election forms are completed.

Darryl swore his Oath of Office aloud.

Mayor Lush advised of the responsibilities of a Councillor. He indicated that it is a Councillor's responsibility to set policy, enact legislation and ensure essential services are provided. He noted that Councillor's are to ensure that the town runs efficiently and effectively.

Mayor Lush discussed the two important matters regarding conflict of interest and code of conduct. He noted that it is an individual Councillor's responsibility to declare themselves in conflict and not the Mayor or Town Clerk. He advised of the matters that are discussed at privileged/closed meetings and that the items that are discussed are confidential in nature and there is liability in discussing a matter outside of such a meeting. He noted that matters discussed in a Regular Council Meeting can be disclosed and discussed with the public.


Mayor Lush advised regarding the committees and the committee structure configuration. It was discussed that Councillor Taylor would be on the Finance Committee for the 2026 Budget preparations.

Mayor Lush discussed the requirement for mandatory training for all Councillors and that it had to be completed within six months.

Lorne, Town Clerk, completed the Code of Conduct Training with Council.
