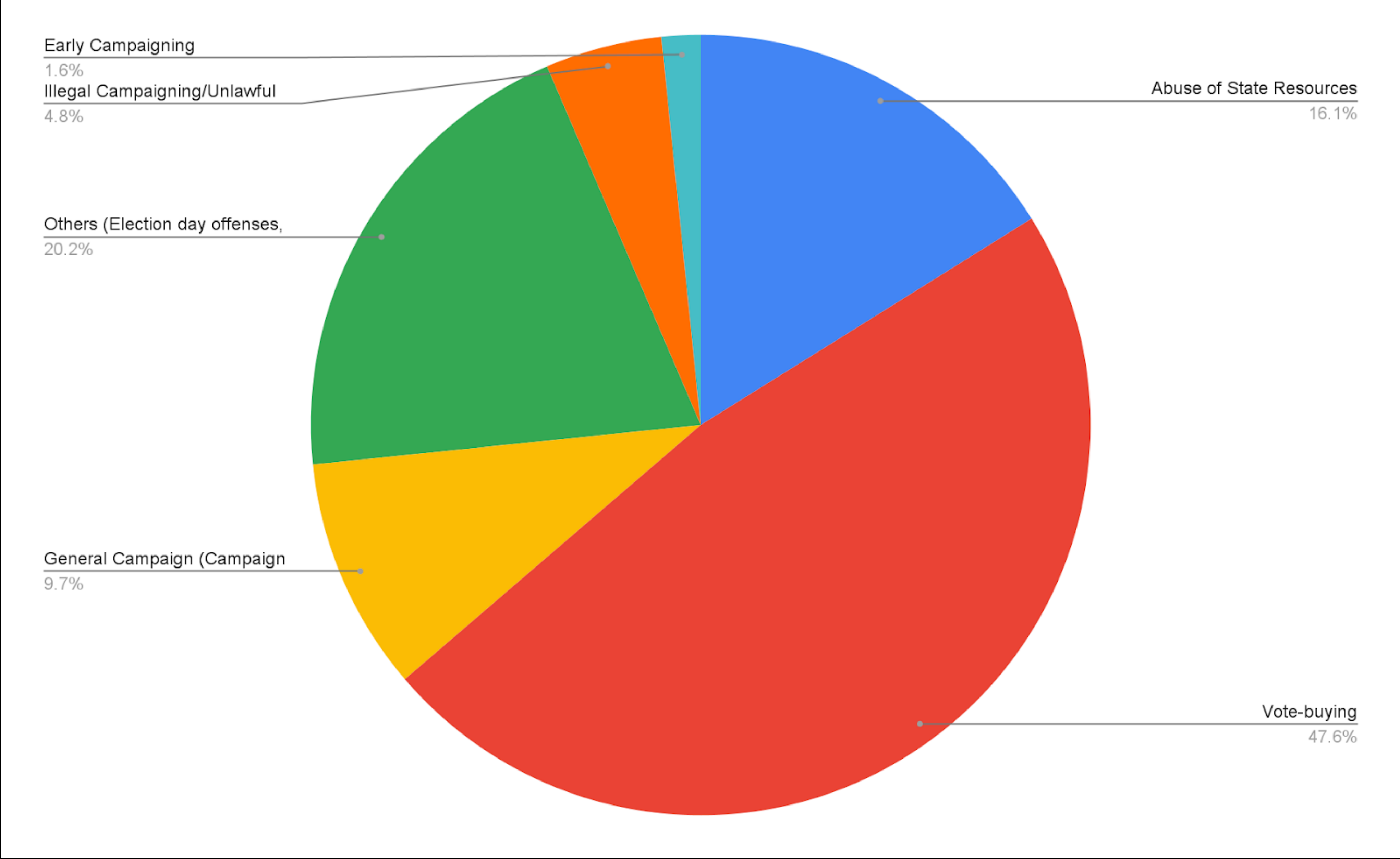


Summary



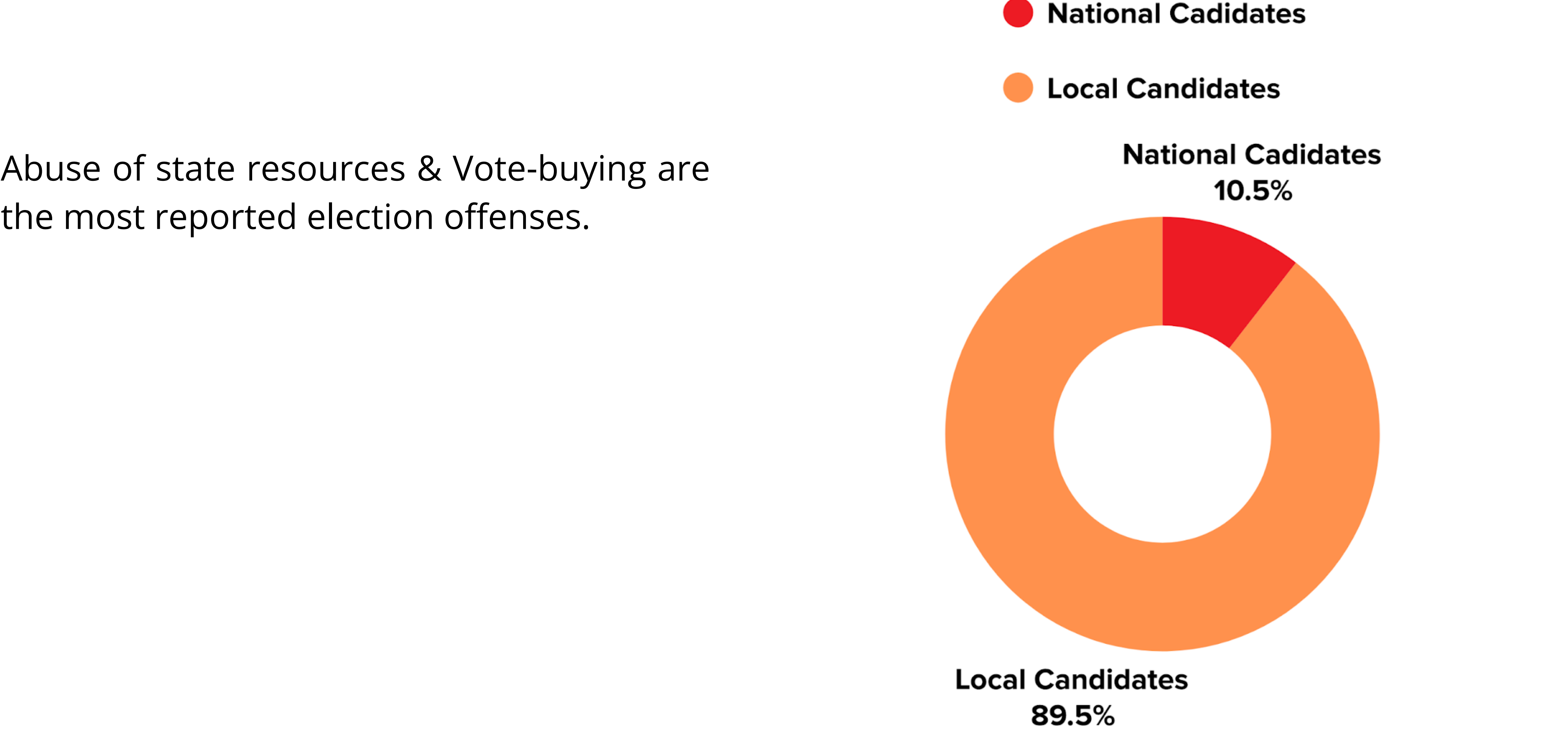
LENTE received a total number of 101 reports covering:

- Vote-buying/Vote-selling
- Abuse of State resources in Elections
- Campaign Violations
- Early Campaigning
- Other Election Day offenses and irregularities

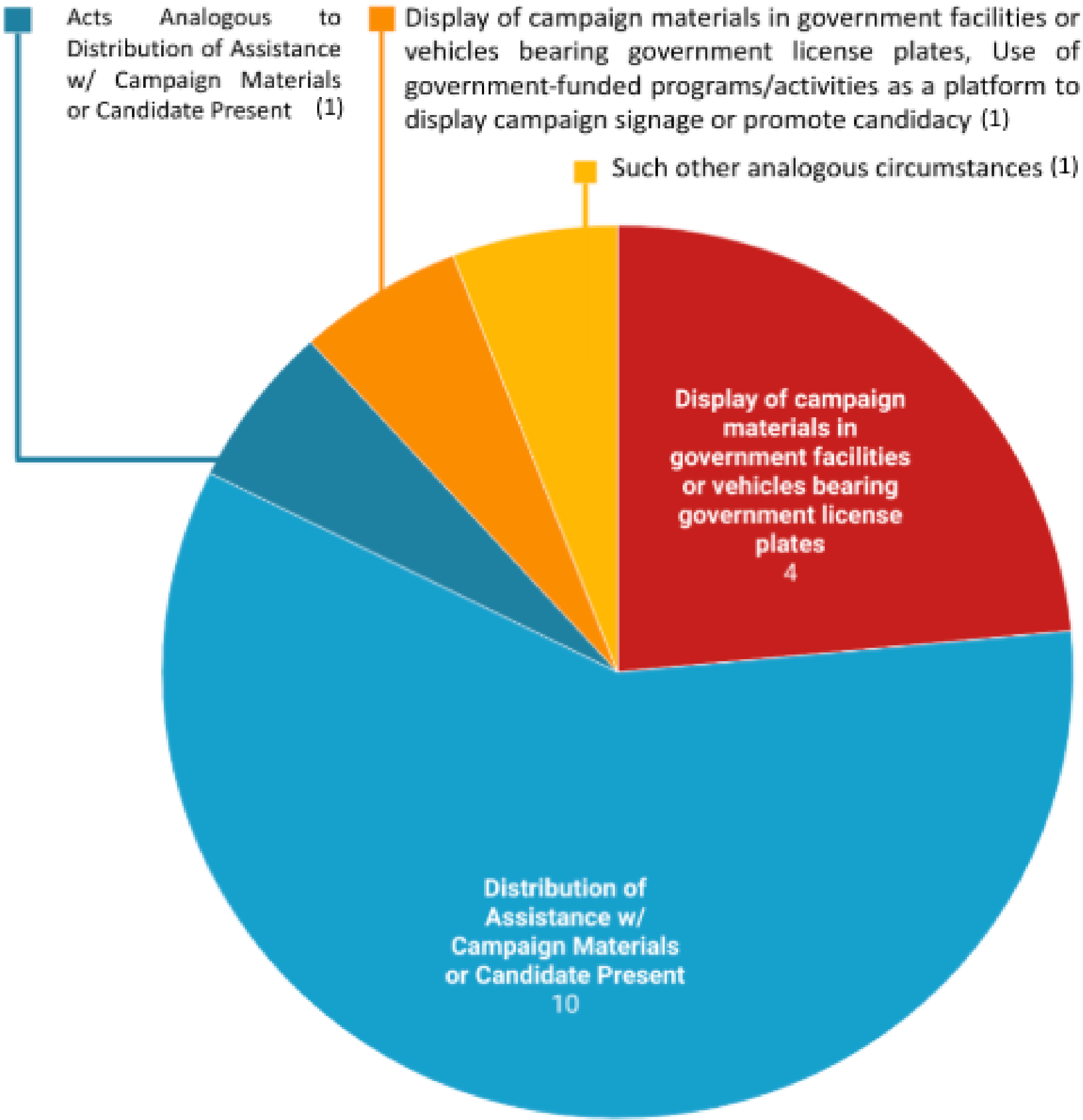
From the start of the campaign period through election day, LENTE logged the most vote-buying reports, followed by abuse of state resources.

Reports increased significantly following the official start of the local campaign period.

VOTE-BUYING PRESUMPTIONS	NUMBER OF REPORTS RECEIVED BY LENTE
Possessing or delivery of any coins, notes, monies, cards, pay envelopes, bags, groceries, tokens or anything of value, together with sample ballots or other campaign materials in favor of or against a candidate;	20 reports
Offering or promising something of value in consideration for someone’s vote;	2 reports
Long lines or queues of registered voters / persons for the distribution	4 reports
Holding of bingo games, talent shows or other similar activities	2 reports
Conducting medical missions, legal aid services, feeding programs or any caravan offering any or all of these services i	3 reports
Giving, distributing and receiving any assistance or “ayuda,” in which the names of the candidates are mentioned, or those conducted in a place where the name or picture of the candidate is visible or displayed,	4 reports
Employing the “hakot” system or the gathering of two (2) or more registered voters to a specific place before election day and on election day,	1 report
General claims of vote buying (without providing details)	2 reports
