CELL PHONE DEVICE POLICY



VaultED™ Cell Pouch

To maintain a focused and respectful learning environment, cell phone use is restricted during instructional time. This policy ensures that students remain attentive, free from digital distractions, and engaged in classroom activities.

POLICY OVERVIEW

- Upon entering School (the classroom), students must place their cell phone into their **Higher Ground VaultEd pouch.**
- The pouch securely stores the device and **blocks RF signals**, preventing calls, texts, and notifications during class time. (to ensure battery life after removal, it is advised to turn off the device or engaging airport mode prior to insertion)
- The **Velcro closure** alerts teachers when a device has been accessed.
- Students will **keep the pouch with them** but may not open during class without permission.

USAGE EXCEPTIONS

- Emergencies: Students may quickly access their phone in emergency situations. (calling for help)
- **After-School Functions**: Devices may be used after the final bell or during school-approved events where cell phone use is permitted.
- **Parent or Guardian Contact:** If a student needs to contact home, they should request to use the school office phone.

ENFORCEMENT

- **First Offense:** Reminder and re-securing of the phone.
- **Second Offense:** Phone will be collected and held until the end of the day.
- Repeated Offenses: Parent or guardian meeting may be required, and further disciplinary action may follow per school policy.
