HISTORY

Founded in 1986, the Outrigger Duke Kahanamoku Foundation (ODKF) has awarded more than \$3 million in scholarships and athletic grants. The organization hosts the Hawai'i Waterman Hall of Fame – honoring legends of water sports - and Duke's OceanFest – continuing Duke's legacy of competition with aloha on Waikiki Beach. In 2019, the foundation hosted the first ever Duke's Night, a community celebration honoring recipients of ODKF college scholarships, including the \$25,000 Duke Award, the largest one-time scholarship in the state.

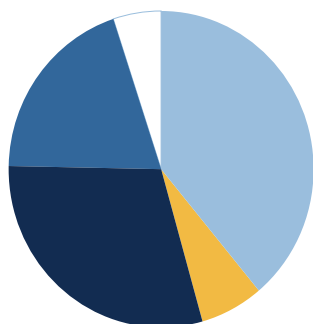

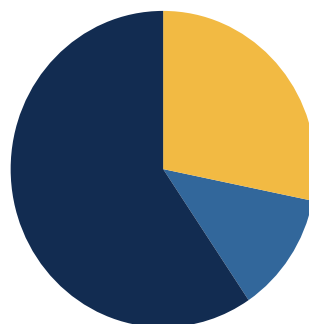
FINANCIAL SUMMARY

In 2019, ODKF launched exciting new initiatives, including the first ever Duke's Night aimed at raising the profile of our scholarship program and focusing public attention on our student scholars. Although we lost a long-term funding source and reduced our scholarships and grantmaking accordingly, we grew our donor base, modernized our donor and volunteer tracking, and streamlined our scholarship applications. We committed to increased digital communication to reduce expenses and revitalized our social media accounts to widen outreach to scholars and donors. We surveyed our scholarship recipients from the past five years, with the intention of reconnecting our scholar alumni network over the coming year. We also hosted a record setting 10th Anniversary Waterman's Hall of Fame in 2019. The ODKF board is committed to responsibly expanding our financial resources and perpetuating the legacy of Duke Kahanamoku.

ALOHA 'OE

Board Member Emeritus Tim Guard recently passed away after serving for twenty years on the ODKF board, including four years as President. He was inducted into the Hawai'i Waterman Hall of Fame in 2017.

Tim received his first surf lesson from Duke Kahanamoku at age 12. He became an avid waterman, crossing the Moloka'i channel at least twenty times by canoe, and winning the prestigious 1957 Makaha Junior Amatuer Surfing Contest and four Moloka'i Hoe Canoe Racing World Championships. Tim was also a decorated Vietnam war hero honored with a Bronze Star, Navy Commendation and Navy Achievement medals, and the RVN Legion of Merit. Tim steadfastly served his community through numerous charitable organizations in addition to ODKF, while working as Chairman & CEO of McCabe, Hamilton & Renny Co., Ltd. - the largest stevedoring company in Hawai'i.

APPLICANTS SHOULD DEMONSTRATE THE SPIRIT OF ALOHA THROUGH LEADERSHIP AND COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT.

At Diamond Head Theatre on February 23rd, 2019, the honored scholarship awardees stood out from the crowd, draped with lei and wearing black event t-shirts featuring Colin Redican's dedicated Duke's Night art. 808 Living Host, Tannya Joaquin, recognized every ODKF scholarship recipient individually on stage and pro surfer Carissa Moore opened the white envelope to reveal Akira Williams of Kauai as the Duke Award winner. The night closed with a tribute by island reggae musician Irie Love and a crowd sing-along with all the scholars on stage.
